
Sizing Your Ring

Buying a new ring in a size that fits means that you can enjoy it right away. Use our Ring Sizing Chart to find that perfect fit IF you already have a ring that fits you well. Otherwise, use our Finger Sizing Tool to measure your finger and determine your ring size.

Ring Sizing Chart


Use this tool if you already have a ring in the size you want. When buying a gift for someone else and using one of their rings, make sure that the ring you are measuring fits on the finger for which the new ring is intended. This chart shows U.S. ring sizes.

- 1. Print out this chart.
- 2. Place the ring over each circle until the INSIDE circle of your ring exactly matches a circle on the chart.
- 3. Note the ring size.



Finger Sizing Tool

Use this tool to measure the finger upon which you will wear your ring.



- 1. Print out the image to the right.
- 2. Carefully cut out the image to create the Finger Sizing Tool; cut a slit on the dotted line near "Your Size."
- 3. With the printing facing outward, slip the pointed end of the tool through the slit, forming a loose loop.
- 4. Place the loop around your finger and pull the pointed end to create a snug fit.
- 5. Find your size by checking the numbered line located at the "Your Size" slit.

Do not wrap too tightly; try slipping the tightened loop over your knuckle without changing the size. If you are between sizes, order the larger size. Ask someone to double check your measurement.

Tips

Your ring should fit comfortably on your finger loose enough to slide over the knuckle and snug enough to stay on your finger.

Measuring tips

Your fingers change size during the day and in different weather. The same finger on different hands may also differ in size. As a result, your ring size for a finger of your dominant hand, e.g., the hand you write with, may be a half size larger that the ring size of the corresponding finger on the other hand.

For best results:

- Measure your finger three to four times in one day to find your sizing range.
- In warm temperatures, measure your finger at the end of the day.
- Make sure to measure the finger on which you intend to wear the ring; don't assume that the same finger on the other hand will have the same ring size.

If you are buying the ring as a surprise gift:

- Ask the recipient's family or friends for a ring size.
- Borrow a ring from the recipient and use the Ring Sizing Chart.
