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#### Northwest Neighborhood

Briscoe	Foster	Collins	McNutt
<p>Briscoe &amp; Shoemaker tower &amp; Gucker provide housing in one-, two-, three-, and four-bed suites with private and semi-private restrooms. Briscoe is coed, undergraduate housing with air conditioning. Depending on the room assigned, there are restrictions on bunking and lofting beds. Restrooms are cleaned weekly by RPS custodial staff. There is no additional charge for this service. Paper supplies are provided, but cleaning supplies are not.</p>	<p>This air-conditioned, coed residence hall is made up of five separate residential buildings (Harper, Martin, Magee, Jenkinson, and Shea) and a public building housing a food court, computer lab, late-night recreation venue, and an ice cream shop. Mostly double rooms and some single rooms are available. Foster has restrictions on bunking/lofting beds, depending on the room assigned.</p>	<p>This coed residence hall is comprised of a central cluster of three four-story buildings (Edmondson, Cravens, and Smith), two satellite buildings (Brown and Greene Halls), and Hillcrest Apartments. Single and double rooms, suites, two-room suites, and one- and two-bedroom apartments are available. Hillcrest does not offer custodial services in the apartments and does not provide paper and cleaning supplies. Collins LLC is a partnership between RPS and the College of Arts and Sciences. The Collins program emphasizes five principles: academics, community, diversity, sustainable living, and student empowerment.</p>	<p>This air-conditioned, coed residence hall is made up of six five-story buildings (North Courtyard: Bryan, Crone, and Bordner and South Courtyard: Dejoya, Bocobo, and Delgado) and one central service building. Mostly double rooms and some single- and triple-occupancy rooms are available. McNutt has restrictions on bunking/lofting beds, depending on the room assigned. The center building at McNutt includes a convenience store, center desk, computer lab, classrooms, and offices for the Kelley LLC and University Division academic advisors. Restroom renovations are underway to replace the communal facilities with several individual rooms that may be locked for privacy.</p>

#### Northeast Neighborhood

BBHN (Bicknell, Banta, Hepburn and Nutt)	Campus View	Evermann Apts.	Redbud Hill	Tulip Tree Apts.
<p>These four 2-story limestone and frame buildings contain 141 unfurnished apartments. Laundry facilities are conveniently located. These buildings have no elevators, air conditioning, or wireless. Ethernet connections are available in the apartments. Resident-owned air conditioners can be installed by RPS maintenance. Bicknell and Hepburn have one-bedroom apartments with a private entrance. Ground-level apartments have patios. The two-bedroom, 2-story townhouses in Banta and Nutt have a private entrance, a small balcony off of the master bedroom, a large storage area under the stairwell, a patio, and a planting area or box.</p>	<p>This air-conditioned 9-story limestone building with elevators contains 223 carpeted two-bedroom apartments. A few apartments have tile floors. In each apartment, the kitchen and living room areas are combined and the hallway is lined with closet space. Approximately half of the apartments have an outside balcony. Wireless and Ethernet connections are available in each apartment. Laundry facilities are located on each floor. A computer lab, music practice room, activities room, and library are centrally located in the building. Apartments located on the ends of the building vary somewhat in size from the typical floor plan.</p>	<p>Located in a 4-story limestone building, Evermann contains 182 efficiency and one-bedroom apartments. Laundry facilities, a meeting room, a music practice room, and a computer lab are centrally located. This building has no air conditioning, elevators, or wireless. Resident-owned air conditioners can be installed by RPS maintenance.</p>	<p>These two 4-story buildings contain 128 two-bedroom apartments. The apartments are divided into groups of eight that share a stairwell. Laundry facilities are centrally located. These apartments do not have air conditioning, elevators, or wireless. Ethernet connections are available in each apartment. Resident-owned window air conditioners can be installed by RPS maintenance.</p>	<p>This air conditioned 11-story building with elevators contains 219 two- and three-bedroom carpeted apartments. A large section of windows covers the outside wall in each apartment. The three-bedroom apartments have two bathrooms. Laundry facilities are located on each floor. Wireless and Ethernet connections are available in each apartment. A computer lab, music practice room, and activity room are centrally located in the building.</p>

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#### Central Neighborhood

<p>Ashton is a coed residence hall comprised of five individual 4-story buildings (Hershey, Johnston, Moffat, Stemple, and Vos) and one central services building. Only single rooms are available. Window air conditioners are provided in all residential rooms. Bunking/lofting of beds is not permitted at Ashton.</p>	<p>Eigenmann is an air-conditioned, coed, 14-story building for undergraduate students. Single, double, and triple-occupancy rooms are available. All rooms have individual thermostats and modular furniture. Eigenmann has restrictions on bunking/lofting beds, depending on the room assigned. University offices are housed on two wings of the building. Several businesses and services are located on the ground floor.</p>	<p>Teter is an air-conditioned, coed undergraduate residence hall constructed of five connected buildings (Boisen, Elkins, Rabb, Thompson, and Wissler). Mostly double and some single rooms are available. Teter has restrictions on bunking/lofting beds, depending on the room assigned. Restroom renovations are underway to replace the communal facilities with several individual rooms that may be locked for privacy.</p>	<p>This apartment complex offers one-, two-, and four-bedroom units to undergraduate students. All units are fully furnished and include eco-friendly washer and dryer, granite countertops in bathrooms, fully carpeted living and bedrooms, tile flooring in bathrooms, wood flooring in kitchen, air conditioning, fire protection/sprinklers, smoke detection, card access security, cable TV service, wireless Internet service, utilities, and insulated windows. Bunking and lofting of beds is not permitted. Cleaning and paper supplies are not provided.</p>	<p>Wright is a coed undergraduate residence hall made up of 18 connected living units called houses (Campbell, Dodds, Dewey, Dunn, Elliot, Ferguson, Hall, Harding, Harney, Hummer, Jenkins, Lowe, Nichols, Parks, Rollins, Ruter, Stockwell, and Todd). Mostly double rooms with a limited number of singles and triples are available. All student rooms offer wall-to-wall carpeting, modular furniture, and overhead lighting. Wright has restrictions on bunking/lofting beds, depending on the room assigned.</p>

#### Southeast Neighborhood

Forest	Read	Willkie	3rd & Union Apts	University East Apts
<p>Forest is a coed, undergraduate residence hall consisting of two 11-story towers and a center building. All three buildings are connected by a breezeway. The towers are home to mostly double rooms, and a few enhanced single rooms. Recent renovations have added air conditioning. Forest has restrictions on bunking/lofting beds, depending on the room assigned. Each tower has a large first floor lounge for study and programmatic space. Due to construction of the Woodland Centre dining facility opening in August 2013, it is necessary for us to close and relocate services located in the center building. The Academic Support Center will be relocated to the center building at Willkie. The classroom, Movies, Music, &amp; More, and technology center will be closed for the 2012-13 academic year. Residents are welcome to use these facilities at Read and Willkie.</p>	<p>Read is a coed, undergraduate residence hall of four wings (Beck, Clark, Curry, and Landes) connected by a central hub. Double, single and large-double rooms are available. Some double rooms have private half-baths; most rooms share a half-bath with another room. The half-baths are cleaned weekly by RPS custodial staff at no additional charge. Paper and cleaning supplies are also provided. Depending on the room assigned, there may be restrictions on bunking and lofting beds.</p>	<p>Willkie is a coed, air-conditioned facility for undergraduate and graduate students. Students must be at least 19 years old or have lived in an RPS residence hall for at least two semesters to live at Willkie. This residence center is composed of two 11-story towers; two apartment buildings; and a central services building. Apartments for three to four students are available. Laundry facilities are included in the apartments and a few are modified for disabled students. The two towers provide several types of suites; all suites have full baths and some are modified for disabled students. Cleaning service for the restrooms, twice a month, is available at an additional charge of \$15 per month for two people. Paper and cleaning supplies are not provided. Bunking and lofting of beds is not permitted at Willkie. Willkie also includes Mason Hall apartments that house six students in double bedrooms. These apartments do not have air conditioning, are open to first-year students, cost considerably less than single or double rooms, and do not require purchase of a meal plan..</p>	<p>This new 4-story limestone building has 102 studio and one-bedroom apartments. All apartment units are air-conditioned and carpeted. Wireless Internet service and Ethernet connections are available in each apartment. A computer lab and laundry facilities are centrally located.</p>	<p>This 4-story limestone building contains 117 efficiency and one-bedroom apartments and is located on East Third Street near the schools of education and music. A computer lab and laundry facilities are centrally located. This building has no air conditioning, elevators, or wireless. Ethernet connections are available in each apartment. Resident-owned air conditioners can be installed by RPS maintenance. Apartments are unfurnished.</p>
