



Limited Warranty General Terms

Corgi USA expressly warrant that Corgi truck and passenger tire changers and Corgi balancers will be free from defects in material workmanship for the times hereafter specified. Corgi USA must be informed in writing within 7 days after discovery of a defect and must be given reasonable opportunity to repair the changer or balancer in order for the original owner to preserve a claim to repair of a machine.

In the absence of abuse or failure to perform any necessary maintenance (i.e. damage due to or resulting from, faulty installation, neglect, misuse, improper electrical connections or sudden surges of electrical power, problems resulting from excess water, air pollution or pollutant agents of any nature, fire or freight damage)

Corgi machines are warranted to the original owner as follows:

Tire Changers

Passenger Tire Changers: Transmission – (10) year warranty on A2024TI, A9824TI, MTS24 (5) year warranty on A9220.
Rubber Pads, air lines, gauges, mount/demount heads, and swabs are warranted for 90 days
(parts & labor) All other components for 12 months (parts & labor) - **covering manufacture defect**
Artigilo Master /AM50- 6 months labor/1year transmission/1year parts-**covering manufacture defect**

Truck Tire Changers: Rubber pads, hoses, air lines and swabs for 90 days (parts only)
6 months labor/1 year parts

Balancers

EM43 & ET66 Balancers: 24 months on main computer board (parts only).
6 months labor/1year

All Other Balancers: 24 months on computer board (parts only)
All other components for 12 months (parts & labor)

Disclaimer & Limitation on Liability

Corgi USA agreement to repair a tire changer or balancer is expressly in lieu of all other warranties, express, implies or statutory, including any warranties for merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.

Corgi USA maximum liability shall be limited to the cost of the machine. In no event shall Corgi USA be responsible for owner's lost profits, goodwill or other incidental or consequential damages.
