

❖ *Will there be child care? Are children allowed at the event?*

No, child care will not be provided at the event. We do ask that you not bring your children to the event, unless you have a new born and are nursing. This is to reduce distraction of the other attendees at the event. This is your time to be ministered too.

❖ *Do you offer any meals during the event?*

The event does not offer any meals, but the hotel offers several restaurants. There are also restaurants and grocery stores just down the road for your convenience.

❖ *Do I have to participate in the breakouts?*

If you're not feeling up to it, you do not have to attend any or all of the breakouts. These are all included in your registration fee and will not be refunded if you decide not to participate.

❖ *Do you record the sessions? Can we record the sessions?*

We do not record the sessions and ask that you do not record them either. We are contracted with the speakers and musical artists; they own their content and retain all rights. You are encouraged to communicate with those speakers and artists for their available content.

❖ *Will we be able to purchase CD's, books, and other things from the speakers and artists?*

We apologize, but there will not be an onsite LifeWay bookstore. Some of our speakers will be offering resources at their exhibit tables during the General Sessions.

❖ *Will we be able to meet the speakers and artists?*

The speakers will be with us all weekend and they would be honored to talk with you.

❖ *Are their Marriage Counselors available during the event?*

Our speakers will be happy to share with you how to find a local counselor in your area. Our speakers encourage people through speaking, personal coaching and resource development.

❖ *I hear there is a vow renewal, is this a requirement?*

The vow renewal is not a requirement, it is optional and completely up to you and your spouse. We will close the general session doors due to the intimacy of the vow renewal for those that are taking part. We will reopen the doors at its conclusion to get ready for the General Session.

❖ *The Date Night Movie, do we have to participate?*

You do not have to participate in these, they are optional.

❖ *Does parking cost, or is it free?*

Parking is free.

❖ *Is there a dress code?*

There is no dress code, but clothing is mandatory. It is best to layer and bring a jacket. The venue could run cold to you when you neighbor is sweltering.
