## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE**

The Quik-Chek Adapter allows quantitative fit tests to be performed on a pressure demand Ultra Elite Firehawk facepiece by only trained and qualified personnel. Special probed facepiece are not required.


#### **A WARNING**

Do NOT use the Quik-Chek adapter on a facepiece in hazardous atmospheres. The Quik-Chek adapter is for quantitative facepiece fit testing ONLY and is not NIOSH approved for use in a hazardous atmospheres. Failure to follow this warning can result in serious personal injury or death.

#### **INSTALLING THE QUIK-CHEK ADAPTER TO** THE FACEPIECE

Suction Cup

- 1. Remove the suction cup from the clip if it is attached. Insert the end of the tube with the clip through the spokes of the spider valve in the facepiece. Carefully pull the tube through.
- 2. Push the Quik-Chek Adapter into the inlet of the facepiece. Check to make sure the spider valve and the inhalation check valve are in place.
- 3. Attach the suction cup to the clip. Moisten the surface of the suction cup and attach it to the inside surface of the lens so that it is positioned between the nose and mouth.
- 4. Don the facepiece. Place a finger over the end of the tubing connector and perform a facepiece tightness test as described in the appropriate respirator instructions.
- Once the respirator has passed the above test, it is ready for quantitative fit testing. Attach the in-mask sampling line from the fit-test measuring device to the tubing connector and proceed with the testing.

Suction Cup -



Take off facepiece. Detach the suction cup from the facepiece. Remove the Quik-Chek Adapter from the facepiece and carefully pull the tube out of the facepiece. Check the facepiece's inhalation check valve and the spider valve for any damage, If they are damage, replace the valves before using the facepiece.
