MSA Competent Persons Inspection of Personal Fall Protection Equipment (PFPE) Training Course—EU

Course No. ZT-CPINSPECT

This course is designed to meet employer moral and legal obligations with regard to detailed examination of workplace fall protection equipment. Successful completion of this training qualifies an individual as a company Competent Person to inspect workplace fall protection equipment.

Basic course focuses upon soft goods, harnesses, lanyards, ropes, and anchor stops. Modules can be added for self-retracting lifelines (SRLs), man-riding winches and rescue systems (manufacturer-dependent). The course can be delivered onsite, providing that a suitable training facility is available, or at an MSA training venue.

Recommended For

This course is suitable for any person responsible for formal examination of personal fall protection equipment (PFPE) within a company or as an individual. Qualification gained ensures that legislative compliance is met with regard to PFPE formal examination. The course is suitable for all industries where PFPE is used.

Course Content

Theory:

- Introduction to use of fall protection equipment
- Relevant legislation, standards and guidelines
- Detailed examination of fall protection equipment
- Logging of examination results and record keeping
- Fall protection equipment care and maintenance
- Additional modules as required including SRLs

Practical:

- Practical demonstrations concerning fall protection equipment inspection
- Review damaged fall protection equipment
- Complete individual inspection sheets, recording individual findings

Course Assessment

Both written and practical assessments are required

Course Duration

Six to eight hours, dependent upon modules required

Maximum Instructor/Student Course Ratio

Eight delegates to one instructor

Course Prerequisite

- Good understanding of local language, spoken, written and read

Course Validity

Upon successful course completion, delegates will be issued a certificate of competence that is valid for three years.
