CHEST STRAP POSITIONING

Some MSA air masks were shipped with the chest strap positioned above the tether. This is not the optimum configuration for the chest strap and tether.



Not Optimum Configuration
Chest strap positioned **ABOVE** the tether.

To provide optimum sensitivity of the PASS motion alarm and help minimize false alarms and also to allow easy access to the FireHawk® M7 Control Module, the chest strap should be positioned below the tether.

At the next flow test, or sooner, inspect the chest strap and tether configuration and if necessary, reposition the chest strap by working it through the larger hole in the tether so it is positioned below the tether, as shown.



Optimum Configuration
Chest strap positioned **BELOW** the tether.
