





# Please Note: These Anchors need a special riveter for the 8mm Bulb Tite rivets.

The riveter required is a Gesipa HN2 BT. Please make enquiries if you are unsure.

## TOP MOUNT ANCHOR POINT KIT INSTALLATION DETAILS Step 1

Secure eyebolt to plate, locking it off, facing the fall direction.

### Step 2

Place plate onto roof deck and fasten 2 x 14G screws through any 2 holes into the purlin/batten. Drill remaining 8 holes using an 8 mm drill bit and fasten with 8 mm Bulbtite rivets. (NOTE: A HN2 BT Gesipa Riveter is required for these rivets)

### Step 3

Remove any shavings to prevent corrosion and install data sign and label. Apply anchor point label within close proximity of anchor (preferably on the plate).

### **Please Note!**

Not all anchors can be used for abseil – contact MSA for details.

Prior to installation, quality of the roof/deck must be assessed for suitability by a competent person.

Min roof sheet thickness: 0.42 mm steel
Min roof sheet length: 2.4M or 3 battens

Pan Mount Plate the centre two fixings require: 2 x 14G x 45mm screws

Crest Mount Plate the centre two fixings require: 2 x 14G x 75mm screws – see Fig. 1



Types of fixings:-




Use this type for fixing into Steel Purlins/Battens




Use this type for fixing into Timber Purlins/Battens


