RFID chips are similar to bar codes, but are more durable and provide more functionality than traditional barcoding.

2. Mobile Handhelds

Traditional inspections are conducted using pen and paper, which is highly inefficient. Mobile handhelds completely digitize the inspection process. Just point the handheld unit toward a harness, and software will walk you through proper inspection criteria with simple clicks. Never take a clipboard out to the field again!
