Cloud & Endpoint Engineer

The primary responsibilities for this position are to ensure the continuity and functionality of the (global) IT infrastructure and to provide help desk support to the Carhartt EMEA/PAC users. This position resolves issues in a timely manner, contributes to departmental projects and provides an efficient channel of communication between users and IT. This position combines local tasks and responsibilities with participation in global initiatives and services.

The Cloud & Endpoint Engineer will collaborate actively with the global (US based) IT team and works closely with the IT System Administrator and other members of the EMEA IT team. Due to the nature of the position, the role regularly collaborates with team members from other EMEA teams.

Some of your duties and responsibilities will be:

- Responsible for continuity and optimal functionality in all IT systems and infrastructure.
- Solve device, application, and connectivity issues and incidents, performs troubleshooting tasks.
- Identifies and records incidents gathering all necessary information to understand and register problems or requests.
- Configure, deploy, and maintain laptops, desktops, and mobile devices.
- Prepares hardware for use by (new) associates; handles access from users to the systems.
- Monitors the tickets mailbox (Carhartt ServiceNow), handling incoming incidents requests and questions, providing (user) support in the office environment (desktops, laptops etc.) and for systems and applications.
- Is in daily/weekly contact with the Carhartt US IT team regarding systems maintenance and issues.
- Enters EMEA issues, questions and events into ServiceNow (IT self-service portal), assigns to the correct level of support.
- Perform system upgrades and migrations in support of business operations.
- Assists company users with the use of applications such as Office365, Teams, SharePoint, Outlook, Excel, RingCentral (telephony) etc.
- Provides follow-up for users with status update and/or resolution/completion updates.



- Enforce endpoint security policies (BitLocker, Defender, Conditional Access).
- Monitor and respond to security incidents related to endpoints and cloud services.
- Ensure compliance with internal and external regulations.
- Collaborate with helpdesk and infrastructure teams.
- Support Active Directory and Group Policy configurations.
- Design and implement scalable Microsoft Intune solutions to enhance device management and security across diverse platforms, ensuring compliance with organizational policies.
- Maintain and upgrade Windows Server environments.
- Participate in Cloud Improvements.
- Support Carhartt VDI environment in Azure.
- Design and implement scalable Microsoft Intune solutions to enhance device management and security across diverse platforms, ensuring compliance with organizational policies.
- Analyze reoccurring problems, research and recommend solutions, and assist in implementation of system resolutions to reduce the reoccurrence of IT problems.
- Work with the incident management team to prioritize escalated incidents and restore normal service quickly to all system interruptions and reduce/eliminate any adverse impact on the business.
- Work with the cyber security team to identify security gaps and harden systems against threats.
- Contributes to short-term and long-term departmental projects, in support of the Sr. Manager IT & Facilities.
