Systems & Integrations Support Analyst

The EMEA Systems & Integrations Support Analyst maintains and provides support for various EMEA systems and applications including B2B Portal, CRM, Project Tools, and other EMEA systems.

Next to that this role will be responsible for the coordination of the setup and maintenance of EDI (Electronic Data Interchange)/API (Application Programming Interface) integrations with our EMEA Wholesale customers.

In this solitary role, the candidate is expected to work independently with little supervision, to have excellent organization and problem-solving skills. This role will be in daily contact with business process owners and stakeholders throughout the company including working with members of the global IT team of Carhartt Inc. (US, Mexico and India) on a regular basis.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Support and maintain all EMEA applications.
- Set up documentation of EMEA applications if needed.
- Create user manuals for (EMEA) applications.
- Execute training sessions for internal end users of the applications.
- Troubleshoot, support, configure and deploy EMEA systems.
- Identify opportunities for process improvements within the managed applications.
- Execute test plans and document results.
- Appropriately identify risks, constraints, and assumptions.
- Work with global technology/network teams to maintain the EMEA systems and infrastructure.
- Partner with internal and 3rd party partners to run projects.
- Reach across functional group to other members of global IT to ensure integration points are understood, supportable and scalable.
- Commit to project timelines, due dates and project methodologies.
- Coordinate the setup of new EDI/API connections with EMEA wholesale customers.
- Document all EMEA EDI/API connections.
- Test EMEA EDI/API connections together with customers.
- Effectively and respectfully communicate with end users and (internal/external) customers to accurately identify and resolve defects/bugs that arise.



What do you bring to the table?

- Bachelor's degree in informatics/computer science or related field or equivalent years of experience.
- 3-5 years of professional experience in managing systems and applications.
- Experience with EDI/API integrations and standards is an absolute must!
- Excellent attention to detail with a focus on user experience.
- Strong ability to quickly understand defects/bugs and technical awareness and know-how to find the source of the issue.
- Work under deadlines while maintaining strong attention to detail and quality of your work; ability to meet timelines.
- Excellent organizational, communication and interpersonal skills, including a strong commitment to follow-up, follow-through, collaboration with cross-functional teams with a sense of urgency.
