
## **HVAC/R Directions**



- To charge the hose assembly and remove the air, first connect the applicator to the hose assembly. When charging the first time, rotate applicator dial 1/2 turn counter clockwise. While depressing the center pin in the anti-blowback valve, depress the calibrated plunger until a small amount of dye exits the hose.
- 2. Attach hose assembly to the low side fitting of the A/C system.
- 3. Pre-set the dialer to the amount of dye to be injected into the system (see chart).
- With the A/C system running, hold the flange between your index and middle fingers and press the plunger with your thumb until the plunger is stopped by the flange.
- 5. Continue running the system until the dye has mixed thoroughly.
- 6. Use the UV light to locate leaks.

Application	System size in lbs. of refrigerant	Dye Amount
Small appliance and auto A/C	Up to 4.9 (2.22 kgs.)	.25 oz (7.5 ml)
A/C or refrigerant systems	Up to 25 lbs. (11.34 kgs)	0.5 oz (15 ml)
Larger systems	Above 25 lbs. (11.34 kgs)	0.5 oz (15 ml) per gal. of oil
