To follow Jesus is to lay down all of these things in order to live for one thing: to honor the <u>King</u>.



Belief, trust, and obedience to God's Word are the foundation of the disciple's life.

We cannot separate faith in Christ from <u>feelings</u> for Christ.

Christ alone can fulfill our <u>desires</u>.

God created us to <u>crave</u>.

Our cravings are designed to be satisfied by our <u>Creator</u>.

Our deepest craving is not ultimately for something but for <u>Someone</u>. God has created us to be satisfied in Him.

Our satisfaction is not found ultimately in gifts but in the <u>Giver</u>.

The trigger of sin involves looking to the things of this world to satisfy us <u>apart</u> from our Creator.

The tragedy of sin is that we <u>run</u> from the One our souls long for most.

Christ alone can <u>guarantee</u> our satisfaction.

We can live for the fleeting pleasures of this world. Or we can live for <u>everlasting</u> pleasure in our God.

God's Word says <u>membership</u> in the local church is extremely important.

God's Word helps us see the importance of church <u>gatherings</u>.

The local church is a visible <u>expression</u> of the universal body of Christ.

God's Word helps us see the importance of church <u>discipline</u>.

God's Word helps us see the importance of church <u>leadership</u>.

God's Word helps us see the importance of church <u>accountability</u>.

Together in the church, we want to know the <u>truth</u> of Christ.
