A Descendant of Jehoiachin; Returned from the Exile (1 Chron. 3:17-19)

A Descendant of Zerubbabel;
the End of the Exile (Matt. 1:12-17)

Ezra

Devoted Himself to Studying, Obeying, and Teaching the Law of the Lord (Ezra 7:10)

Jesus

The Scriptures, Including the Law of the Lord,
Testify About Him (John 5:39,46)

Nehemiah

A Man of Prayer (Neh. 1:5-11; 2:4;
4:9; 5:19; 6:9,14; 13:14,22,29,31)
