## **conversation starter**

## **>** navigating the conversation:

- Encourage Self-Reflection: Ask them to think about activities that bring them joy and fulfillment.

  Discuss areas where they naturally excel and find themselves most passionate.
- **Explore Various Talents:** Talk about a variety of talents and gifts, such as artistic abilities, leadership qualities, compassion, problem-solving skills, or a heart for service.
- Share Biblical Examples: Discuss stories of biblical figures like Joseph, who had the gift of interpretation, or Esther, who displayed courage and leadership. Explore how they used their gifts for God's purposes.
- Look Beyond the Obvious: Sometimes, talents might not be immediately apparent.
   Encourage them to explore different activities and opportunities to discover hidden abilities.
- Consider Spiritual Gifts: Introduce the concept of spiritual gifts found in passages like 1 Corinthians 12 and Romans 12:6-8. Discuss how spiritual gifts can be used in conjunction with natural talents.
- **Discuss the Purpose of Gifts:** Study how gifts and talents are meant to serve others and bring glory to God. Emphasize the importance of using talents with a heart of humility and service.
- **Support Their Passions:** Show support for their interests and passions, even if they differ from your own.
