HO HASN'T ATTENDED a professional baseball game and sung the familiar lines, "Buy me some peanuts and Cracker Jack"? The song dates back to 1908, by which time the boxed confection of molassesflavored, caramel-coated popcorn and peanuts had become what some historians

consider to be America's first junk food. First sold in 1896, the tasty treat quickly became a staple not only at baseball games but also of American childhoods because after 1912. Cracker Jack® offered "a prize in every box": a baseball card, plastic figurine, whistle, joke booklet, stickers, temporary tattoos, or a decoder ring.

Many children loved anticipating the prize inside while munching on handfuls of Cracker Jack. Others, too excited to wait. thrust a hand far inside the box to fish for the "free" trinket. Today some of those treasures are nearly priceless, such as a Ty Cobb baseball card that sold in 2017 for \$430,000.

That tiny Cracker Jack prize, infinitely multiplied, is something like the wonderful gift God gives to every human soul who turns from sin and finds new life through faith in Jesus Christ, It's the beautiful treasure which

Colossians 1:26-27 describes as "the mystery hidden for ages and generations but now revealed to his saints ... which is Christ in you, the hope of glory." It's the indwelling Spirit of Jesus Christ Himself living in those who trust Jesus to forgive, cleanse, and redeem them. And when Christ comes, He brings with Him a new life. It is an eternal
