HE FIRST SUNDAY in May is designated as Senior Adult Day to ... express appreciation to senior adults for their service in the kingdom of God and their work in the church.

- observe how senior adults use their spiritual gifts.
- make other age groups aware of the blessings of senior adults.
- praise God for the contributions of senior adults.

PLANNING FOR SENIOR ADULT DAY

- 1. Planning originates from the senior adult council, coordinator, staff person, or planning committee.
- 2. Subcommittees are appointed to deal with attendance, worship, choir, ministry activities, food, transportation, and publicity.
- 3. Activities are scheduled.

SENIOR ADULT WEEK

- Ministry: Select activities such as visiting residents at nursing homes or taking meals to those who are homebound.
- Fellowship meal: Treat seniors to a meal.
- Special programs: Enlist speakers and guests.
- Senior adult retreat: Provide a time of reflection, fellowship, and fun.
- Special emphases: Feature one each day.

Hymn 454 — "My Faith Has Found a Resting Place" (segue to next hymn)

Hymn 456 — "How Firm a Foundation"

Hymn 447 — "It Is Well With My Soul"

Offertory Prayer

Piano Offertory — "Because He Lives" (*Pedalpoint*, Spring 2019)

Choral Worship — "Oh, What Love" (The Senior Musician, Spring 2019)

Message — "Retired to Serve" or "My Soul Is Satisfied with Jesus"*

Hymn of Response 622 — "Satisfied With Jesus" **Announcements**

Benediction

Choral Response Benediction 449 — "Because He Lives" (Roll an E-flat on the piano and organ; cue the choir and congregation to sing the chorus in parts, followed by modulation and the repeated chorus in unison.)

Piano/Organ Postlude — "Hallelujah! What a Savior" (*Pedalpoint*, Spring 2019)
