T WAS A BOX-OFFICE FLOP when it released in 1946, despite being the first postwar movie to star Jimmy Stewart, the leading man of the film. Though It's a Wonderful Life was nominated for five Academy Awards, it wasn't considered a success until the late 1970s, when it became a perennial holiday favorite. The story still evokes fond memories for many, who consider it an indispensable part of their Christmas celebrations.

Stewart played George Bailey, a man who felt like a failure and planned to commit suicide by throwing himself off a bridge on Christmas Eve — until he meets his fictional quardian angel, Clarence Odbody. Clarence reveals to George how his neighbors, friends, and family would have


been different had he not been born. It's a life-changing revelation. After Clarence's intervention, George pleads with God from the bridge: "I want to live again! I want to live again! Please, God, let me live again!" His prayer is answered, and George is born again into a wonderful life. It's a nice story.

But in a real-life account from the Bible, Jesus once told a visitor, "'Truly, I tell you, unless someone is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God'" (John 3:3).

His listener replied, "How can anyone be born when he is old?" (John 3:4).

Jesus explained He was speaking of a spiritual reality only He could bring about: "The Son of Man must be lifted up, so that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life. For God loved the world in this way: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life" (John 14-16).
