SESSION 1:God Is Love

God's love reflects His character and His concern for His creation.

John 3:16; 17:23-24; 1 John 4:8-19

SESSION 2: God Carved His Love in Stone Each of the Ten Commandments reflects God's love for people.

Exodus 20:1-17

SESSION 3: God's Love Never Quite God's love for us does not waver in the face of our wrongdoing.

Hosea 11:1-9

SESSION 4: God Wrote His Love in Red John 3:16 gives the gospel of God's love in a single verse.

SESSION 5:God Love You Even When You Don't Love Him

God loves us regardless of whether we love Him. Luke 15:11-32

SESSION 6: God Loves You When He Is Correcting You

Even God's discipline of us is a reflection of His love. Hebrews 12:5-11

SESSION 7: God's Love Will Never Let You Go Nothing can separate a child of God from the love of God.

Romans 8:35-39

SESSION 8: God Loves You and Wants You with Him Forever

SESSION 9: The Nature of Our Enemy

The real devil persistently follows his well-planned attack against us, and we cannot defeat him in our own strength.

2 Corinthians 11:3; Ephesians 6:12

SESSION 10: The Outcome of the Battle The devil will attack, but God is in control anyway. Isaiah 59:1; 1 Timothy 6:12; Revelation 20:10

SESSION 11: The Enemy's Snares The devil attempts to entrap us with debate, division, doubt, and deception. Genesis 3:4; Ephesians 6:11; Revelation 12:9-10

SESSION 12: Extinguishing Fiery Darts Understanding how the devil works can help us prepare to contend with his temptations. 2 Corinthians 10:3-6; Ephesians 6:16

SESSION 13: Responding to Temptation We can resist temptation when we refuse to make excuses and follow the example of Jesus.
