SESSION 1: Be a Servant Whose Inner World Is in Order

Our priorities create the order or disorder of our lives. Ephesians 5:15-17

SESSION 2: Be a Biblically Minded Servant A biblical mind has been transformed by God's Word and the Spirit to think, value, and behave as God desires.

Romans 12:2; 2 Corinthians 10:4-5

SESSION 3: Be a Set-Apart Servant God's servants are to be set apart to holy lives and holy living.

2 Corinthians 6:17; 1 Peter 1:15-16

SESSION 4: Be a Servant of His Presence God's servants long for His presence. Exodus 33:13-15

SESSION 5: Be a Servant of a Life Well-Lived God's servants live life for God's glory. Isaiah 43:7; 1 Corinthians 10:31; 2 Timothy 4:6-7

SESSION 6: Be a Servant Shaped by the Gospel God's servants are shaped by the gospel. 2 Corinthians 5:11-21

SESSION 7: Be a Servant of Purpose God's servants find their purpose and meaning in seeking His glory. Ecclesiastes 1–2

SESSION 8: Be a Servant Who Lives His Call God's servants live out His call on their lives. Acts 13:36; Colossians 3:23

SESSION 9: Jesus

Real change comes only by knowing the real Jesus. Matthew 11:29; Ephesians 3:8

SESSION 10: Despair and Union

Real change comes only after we despair over our sin and recognize our union with Jesus.

SESSION 11: Embrace

Real change comes only when we experience Jesus's embrace of love.

Real change comes only when we live solely in the acquittal of God's justification.

Galatians 2:11-16

Real change comes only when we are honest about our sins and struggles.
