HOW TO USE THIS STUDY

I'm so grateful you're learning with me what it means to preach truth to your own heart. It is such a privilege to come along on this journey with you as we study God's Word, reminding ourselves who He is and who we are because of Him.

This study may be structured a little differently than studies you've done in the past, so I wanted to take a moment to explain how to use it.

GROUP TIME

I would encourage you to get a group of friends together to walk through this study. When we join hands and walk through the Bible in community, we're reminded of the God who is with us and His commands to care for one another. We have the opportunity to witness His work in the lives of our friends and be reminded of His work in our own lives as well. Encourage and challenge one another as you grow and dwell on the truth.

You'll notice there are four parts to each group time: Welcome, Engage, Discuss, and Pray. We have crafted each section with you and your group in mind, and we especially think you'll love the unique Engage sections we included. Session 1—Kickoff will only include a Group Time as you're just beginning to get to know each other. The remaining six Group Times will take place at the end of each session in order to reflect on and discuss the work you completed in your Personal Study.

HEY LEADERS!

Check out the Leader Guide in the back of this book for some tips on leading well through the study. I know you're going to do great!

PERSONAL STUDY This Bible study is meant to be just that—a place for you to study Scripture, jot down questions and answers and prayers, and chart how God is using His Word to teach you more about His heart. Because I'm going to ask you to put into practice what we're learning, I broke the sessions up in sections instead of days. My hope is that this encourages you to take time where you need to hang out a bit longer and dive deep into the truth of Scripture. You can choose when and how long you spend on each section—completing all of them at once, or a little each day, according to your personality and schedule.



BEFORE YOU GET STARTED

There are a few things I want to encourage you to have on hand for each session. You'll definitely need your Bible and a pen every time you open your Bible study book. Other fun things that may be helpful are headphones for listening to music, a journal for additional notes, and colored pencils for the couple of places I have you bring out your inner artist.

As you begin, discuss the following questions with your group: What do you hope to learn from this Bible study?

What words would you use to describe your relationship with God's Word?

How do you hope your relationship with His Word changes throughout this study?

ENGAGE

Grab colored pencils and your favorite snacks, then find a fun spot to sit and color the following pages while you get to know the members of your group. You can even trace the verse as you practice reciting it. As you color and trace, ask each other both silly and a few serious questions to help get the conversation going. You can also cut the page out when you finish in order to display your art or the verse somewhere you'll see often.

DISCUSS

Take a few moments to think through these questions and discuss them with your small group.

What are some of the most common thoughts you have during a good day? What do you think about on a bad or challenging day?

Read Psalm 42:5-6. How would you describe the psalmist's current state?

Instead of wallowing in self-pity or letting emotions take over, what does the psalmist do?

Help us to study your Word, open the eyes of our hearts that we might understand it, and teach up to speak it back to ourselves, in and through every geagon. Amen.
