SESSION 5: Killing Sin

Believers must be aggressive, intentional, and consistent in their war against personal sin.

SESSION 6: Spiritual Disciplines ... for the Purpose of Godliness

Spiritual disciplines are necessary for attaining godliness.

1 Timothy 4:7

SESSION 7: Biblical Intake ... for the Purpose of Godliness

No Spiritual Discipline is more important than the intake of God's Word.

2 Timothy 3:16; James 1:22-25

SESSION 8: Prayer ... for the Purpose of Godliness

To be like Jesus (godly), we must learn to pray as He did.

Luke 11:1; Colossians 4:2; 1 Thessalonians 5:17

SESSION 9: Worship ... for the Purpose of Godliness

Godliness requires both public & private worship done in both spirit & truth.

Matthew 4:10; 15:8-9

SESSION 10: Evangelism ... for the Purpose of Godliness

Godliness requires that we discipline ourselves in the practice of evangelism.

Colossians 4:5-6

SESSION 11: Serving ... for the Purpose of Godliness

Believers are called to serve the Lord in their giftedness with proper motivation.

Joshua 24:15

SESSION 12: Stewardship ... for the Purpose of Godliness

Godliness depends on one's stewardship of time and financial resources.

1 Corinthians 4:2; 9:6-14; Ephesians 5:15-17

SESSION 13: Silence and Solitude ... for the Purpose of Godliness

Godliness will not happen apart from times alone with God.
