WEEK ONE

- <u>Prayer</u> still matters.
- Stillness is still essential.

WEEK TWO

"This is My beloved Son . . . <u>listen</u> to Him!" MATTHEW 17:5

The <u>Holy Spirit</u> is the primary way that you hear from God.

The Holy Spirit is your <u>seal</u>.

"If the sin of Old Testament times was the rejection of God the Father, and the sin of New Testament times was the rejection of God the Son, then the sin of our times is the rejection of God the Holy Spirit."¹

The Holy Spirit is your <u>pledge</u>.

Every human being—saved or unsaved—is made up of three parts—<u>Body</u>, <u>Soul</u>, and <u>Spirit</u>.

If the Holy Spirit lives in you, you haven't been <u>changed</u>, you have been exchanged.

<u>Relationship</u> is the prerequisite for <u>recognition</u> of God's voice.

A "red light" of conviction is His way of saying "<u>STOP</u>." The "yellow light" of dis-ease means "<u>WAIT</u>." A "green light" of ease and peace is His way of saying "<u>GO</u>."

WEEK THREE

"But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will <u>guide you into all the truth</u>; for He will not speak on His own <u>initiative</u>, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come." **JOHN 16:13**

The Greek word for guide means <u>to lead someone who is already on one's</u> <u>way.</u> Or, a person who advises, points out, and shows others the way.¹

1. He guides you progressively.

"... so that we may know the things <u>freely given</u> to us by God" **1 CORINTHIANS 2:12**

If He gives us too much, we'll either <u>rush</u> impatiently toward it, or we'll be so intimidated by His assignment that we will <u>recoil</u> from it and run in the opposite direction.

- 2. He guides you personally.
- 3. He guides you *internally*.

There is an <u>internal layer of truth</u> that we do not have access to in our own human wisdom.

<u>Strongholds</u> stand against the knowledge of God.

WEEK FIVE

Principle #1—God <u>manifests His presence</u> in the desert.

Bushes don't burn in <u>palaces</u>. They burn in deserts.

<u>The key</u> to seeing God's plan while in the desert is to take your attention off of the <u>circumstances</u> and place them on God's presence in the circumstances.

Principle #2—God <u>equips you</u> for His purposes in the desert.

He's giving you the <u>character</u>, the substance, the <u>fortification</u>, the foundational work that will be necessary for Him to accomplish His work through you.

Principle #3—God <u>recharts</u> your <u>course</u> in the desert.

The one thing is relationship with Jesus Christ.

"My <u>sheep</u> hear My voice, and I <u>know</u> them, and they <u>follow Me</u> ..." **JOHN 10:27**

1. The Relationship—My sheep

When you become a believer, you become a part of the <u>family of</u> <u>God</u>.

"Therefore you are no longer outsiders (exiles, migrants, and aliens, excluded from the rights of citizens), but you now share citizenship with the saints (God's own people, consecrated and set apart for Himself); and you belong to God's [own] household." **EPHESIANS 2:19 (AMPCE)**

2. The Result—Hear My voice

Expect God to speak.

<u>Delays</u> and <u>detours</u> are divine interruptions.

3. The Reason—I know them

4. The Response—They follow Me
