### SESSION 1: The Beginning

God begins to weave the seamless revelation of His plan from the opening of the Bible.  
Genesis 1–11

### SESSION 2: The Patriarchs

God raised up and worked through the patriarchs as part of His seamless plan for humanity.  
Genesis 12–50

### SESSION 3: The Exodus

God's seamless plan for humanity included leading His people out of Egyptian slavery and giving them guidance for living.  
Exodus–Numbers 12

### SESSION 4: The Promised Land

As part of God's seamless plan, He led His people into the land He had promised Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.  
Numbers 13–1 Samuel 8

### SESSION 5: The Kingdoms and the Prophets

Despite His people's frequent wickedness, God used kings and prophets to fulfill His promises and to refocus His people's attention on His seamless plan.  
1 Samuel 9–Malachi

### SESSION 6: The Messiah

The seamless nature of God's plan comes together in the Messiah, Jesus Christ.  
Matthew–Acts 12

### SESSION 7: The Letters

Following Jesus's death and resurrection, the Bible continues to reflect God's seamless plan in the spread of the gospel and the anticipation of the close of earthly history.  
Acts 13–Revelation

### SESSION 8: Unconverted Believers

Being a Christian means more than believing in Jesus; it requires following Him.  
Matthew 4:19; 7:13-14,21-23

### SESSION 9: The Great Invitation

Salvation is not primarily a matter of inviting Jesus into one's heart, but a matter of responding positively to Jesus's invitation to follow Him.  
Matthew 4:18:22; John 15:16

### SESSION 10: Superficial Religion and Supernatural Regeneration

Following Jesus results in a changed life because of the Spirit of Jesus coming into the believer.  
Ezekiel 36:25-28; Matthew 4:19; John 3:3,5

### SESSION 11: Don't Make Jesus Your Personal Lord and Savior

Following Jesus means believing Him and proclaiming Him to others.  
Matthew 4:19; 28:19-20; Philippians 1:21

### SESSION 12: Children of God

God desires disciples to follow Him as children follow a parent, not as servants follow a master.  
Matthew 4:19; 6:6-9

### SESSION 13: Born to Reproduce

Followers of Jesus are intended and enabled to make other followers of Jesus.  
Matthew 4:19; 2 Timothy 2:2
