We are so excited that you have decided to lead your teen son or daughter through this study! The theme of *Grace Culture* is helping your teen learn how grow in Jesus. We live in a world that is quick to cancel people—not just for mistakes but for disagreeing with whatever the dominant opinion might be. Watch the weekly video with your teen.

The Leader Helps beginning on page 92 will also be a helpful tool as you lead your teen each week.

These videos are intended to speak directly to your teen and the station of life he or she is in currently. As you know, no two teens are alike. Steer your discussion to where your teen is in his or her walk with the Lord. Trust God and listen for His voice. He will give you discernment as you lead.

Please note the fill-in-the-blanks found in each session of the *Grace Culture* Bible study book. These will help your teen focus as you watch the videos together.

STUDY

Don't Forget to Pray

Work through your individual *Grace Culture* study books throughout the week. We encourage you to discuss what the Lord is teaching you individually. It will be unproductive to lead this study without doing the three days of personal study. Gently encourage your teen to stay on track and push yourself to do the same. We realize your lives are busy and many teens are stretched too thin, but this study is most effective when students work through it one day at a time and are not cramming multiple days together just to get it done.

CONNECT

Plan time each day to work on personal study to keep each other accountable.

Be open with your teen throughout the week about things you learn or have questions about. Provide a safe place for him or her to do the same.

Don't stress! Make a plan and follow through. If you need to go at your own pace, that's fine. Just don't give up if the road gets rough. The destination is worth the journey!

Q: How old does my teen need to be for this study?

A: This study is recommended for teens ages 13 and up, but use your discernment.
