

The Severn Sayings of the Saviour on the Cross by Arthur Pink

Session 1: The Word of Forgiveness Reveal that Christ's death on the cross shows us His divine love and forgiveness.

Luke 23:34

Session 2: The Word of Salvation Illustrate the grace of God in salvation through the story of the repentant thief on the cross. Luke 23:42-43

Session 3: The Word of Affection Reveal Christ's authority and affection even while fulfilling His mission on the cross. John 19:25a-26

Session 4: The Word of Anguish Convey the anguish of Christ on the cross, the gravity of sin, the justice of God, and the depth of Christ's love.

Session 5: The Word of Suffering Emphasize the humanity of Christ by His thirst on the cross. John 19:28

Session 6: The Word of Victory Understand that Christ's, "It is finished," revealed His victory in redemption, fulfilled all prophecies, and conquered sin, death, and Satan. John 19:30

Session 7: The Word of Contentment Emphasize Christ's ultimate trust and contentment in the Father's care as He willingly commended His spirit into God's hands at His death. Luke 23:46

Session 8: God Speaks Help believers understand how God speaks and how to respond with obedience. Deuteronomy 8:3

Session 9: God Speaks by the Holy Spirit God speaks through His Holy Spirit, and that the Holy Spirit empowers, guides, convicts, and teaches believers to accomplish God's purposes. John 16:13

Session 10: God Speaks Through the Bible God speaks to His people through the Bible, and His Word provides guidance, direction, and life to those who listen and obey. 2 Timothy 3:16-17

Session 11: God Speaks Through Prayer Prayer is a dynamic relationship with God through which He speaks to us, transforms us, and guides us in accordance with His will. Jeremiah 33:3
