SESSION 1: Their Purpose and Pain

Delays are necessary, though painful, parts of reaching our destiny.

Genesis 37:2-28; Romans 5:3-5

SESSION 2: Their Pattern and Purifying

While detours are personalized and specific, they tend to have the common elements of testing, training, and temptation.

Genesis 39:1-20

SESSION 3: Their Proof and Presence

God's detours are not to be confused with normal consequences of life.

Genesis 39:6–40:23

SESSION 4: Their Promotion and Plan

Before God's detour for you concludes, He will disappoint you, then surprise you.

Genesis 41:1-32

SESSION 5: Their Pardon and Pleasure

Forgiveness plays a key role in negotiating God's detours.

Genesis 41:50-52; 42:14-17; 45:1-15

SESSION 6: Their Providence and Perfection

God providentially orchestrates our detours to accomplish His purposes.

Genesis 50:20; Romans 8:28-29

SESSION 7: Their Perspective and Peace

The proper perspective while on God's detours allows believers to have peace.

Genesis 41:16; 45:5-9; 50:20

SESSION 8: Holy, Holy, Holy

When we see God as He truly is, we will see Him as holy.

Isaiah 6:1-8

SESSION 9: The Trauma of Holiness

Encountering holy God is unsettling and uncomfortable.

Mark 4:35-41; Luke 5:1-8

SESSION 10: Holy Justice

God's holy justice reflects that His instructions are to be taken seriously.

Leviticus 10:1-3; 1 Chronicles 13:1-11

SESSION 11: Holy Justice (cont.)

God's holy justice is always justified.

Deuteronomy 7:1-6; Ezekiel 18:4

SESSION 12: War and Peace with a Holy God

Peace with holy God only follows surrender to Him.

Romans 5:1-2

SESSION 13: Be Holy Because I Am Holy

God expects His people to be holy.

Leviticus 11:44; Romans 12:1-2
