Recliner Assembly Instructions

Step 1: The recliner back ships unattached to the recliner base.




Step 4: To attach the chair back to the base: Align the two receiver clips on the recliner back with the two support (Figure 5) arms in the chair base. Apply gentle downward pressure. The back is attached when the clips "click" into place. Confirm attachment by pulling up on the back of the recliner.


Step 2: There are two back support arms (Figure 2) one on each side of the seat (Figure 3) that extend up from the recliner base mechanism.





Step 5: For a neater appearance, the skirt on the recliner back (Figure 6) should be wrapped under and affixed to the metal support rail using the factory installed hook and loop fastener. (Figure 7)





Step 3 :The recliner back has two receiver clips (Figure 4) mounted on the inside of the frame to receive the back support arms.





To remove the chair back from the base: Reach inside the back frame. While applying gentle upward pressure on the recliner back, release the spring mechanism on the receiver clip to disengage.
