
## Assembly Instructions For Sumac Guest and Oversize Chairs

**Tools required:** Allen wrenches (included in hardware pack)

**Note:** These instructions are intended for various models and configurations. Your products may not look exactly as those shown in the diagrams.

**Recommendation:** Retighten all bolts on a seasonal basis to ensure your product remains strong and stable for many years of use.

Weight Capacity: All guest chairs in this series have a weight capacity of 300 lbs. per seat unless otherwise stated.




## **Assembly Instructions** For Sumac Guest and Oversize Chairs

Recommendation: Retighten all bolts on a seasonal basis to ensure your product remains strong and stable for many years of use.

Weight Capacity: All guest chairs in this series have a weight capacity of 300 lbs. per seat unless otherwise stated.

- 6. Place second leg frame on top of assembly, as shown in figure 5. Be sure back support bar is inserted into slot in leg frame. Secure using 3/8" and 1/2" Allen bolts.
- 7. Return chair to an upright position.
- 8. Gansett chairs have dual-position seats. They can be assembled with or without a cleanout, as shown in the Seat Options diagram.
- 9. Attach seat to H-frame using 2" Allen bolts, as shown in figures 6 and 7. Use front set of H-frame holes for a seat with cleanout and use the back set of holes for a seat without cleanout.
- 10. Tighten all 12 bolts securely.
- 11. Your chair is now assembled and ready to use.
