







PHILLIPS SCREWDRIVER.

NOTE:

- 1 - Locate the Hardware Pack.
- 2 - Once all items are removed from carton, inspect carton for any parts that may have come loose during shipment.
- 3 - Please read through the instructions before you attempt to assemble.
- 4 - It is recommended to use two people during the assembly process.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Unpack all from box.
 2. Place the TOP (#2) top down on soft surface (can use protective foam from packaging material)

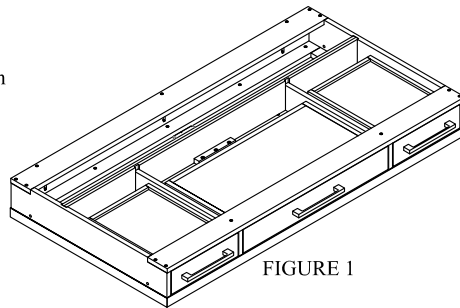

3. open the drawers to gain access to assembly points.
4. Position the SIDE PANELS. (#1)
5. Insert two BOLTS ("A") into holes and secure with ALLEN WRENCH ("B") Fig.2.

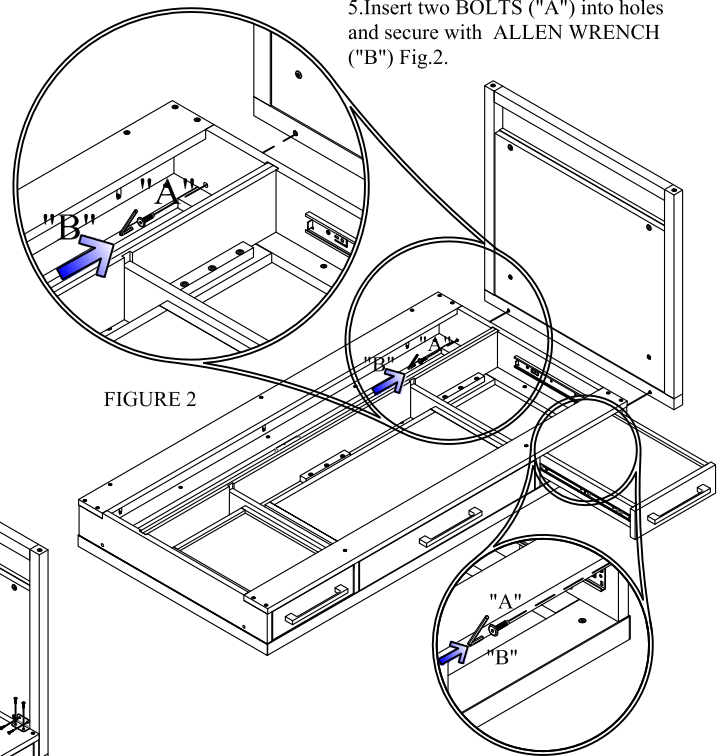

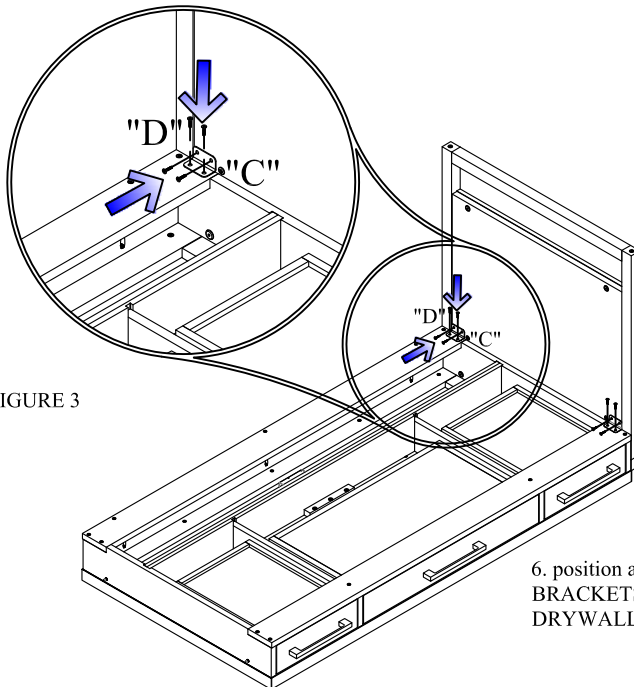

6. position and secure two BRACKETS ("C") using eight 3/4" DRYWALL SCREWS ("D") Fig.3.

CARING FOR YOUR FURNITURE:

- * Using solvents of any kind on your furniture may damage your furniture finish.

7. repeat steps 5 & 6 to attach the second SIDE PANELS(#1)

8. Utilizing the remaining four BRACKETS ("C"), position MODESTY PANEL (#3) and secure with remaining 3/4" BLACK DRYWALL SCREWS ("D") as shown in Fig.4.

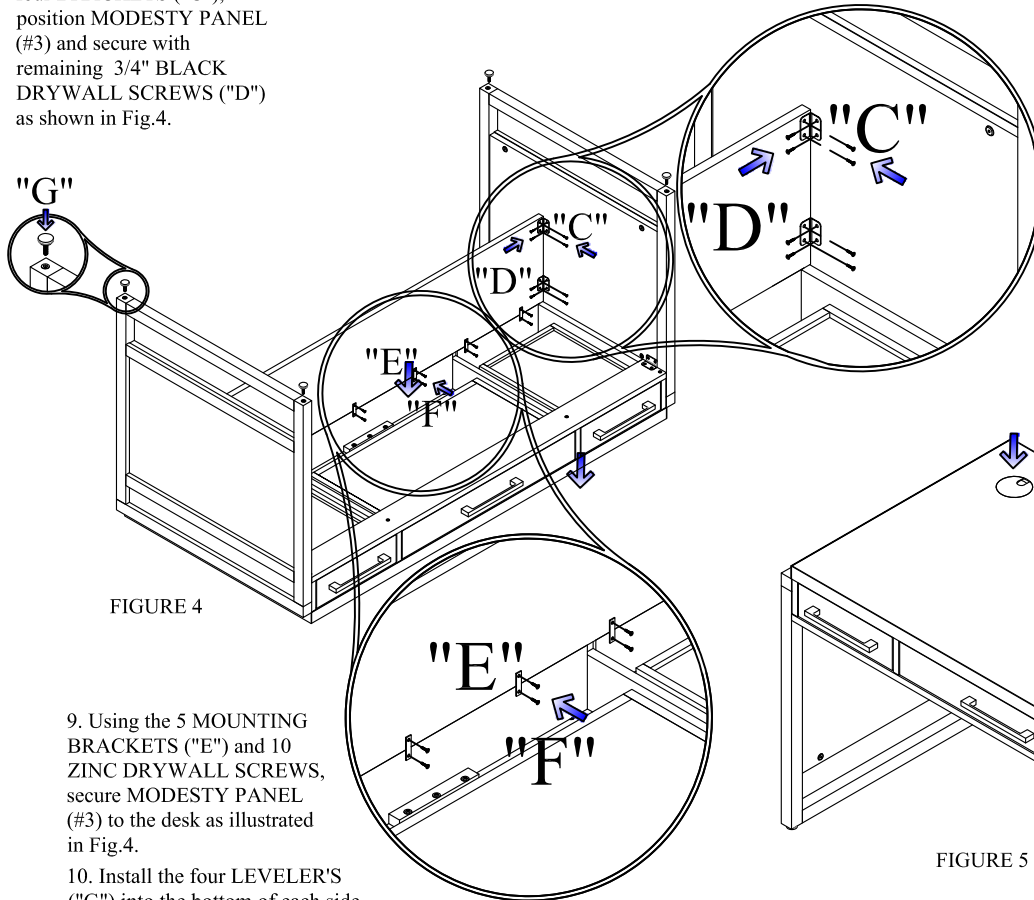

9. Using the 5 MOUNTING BRACKETS ("E") and 10 ZINC DRYWALL SCREWS, secure MODESTY PANEL (#3) to the desk as illustrated in Fig.4.

10. Install the four LEVELER'S ("G") into the bottom of each side panels.

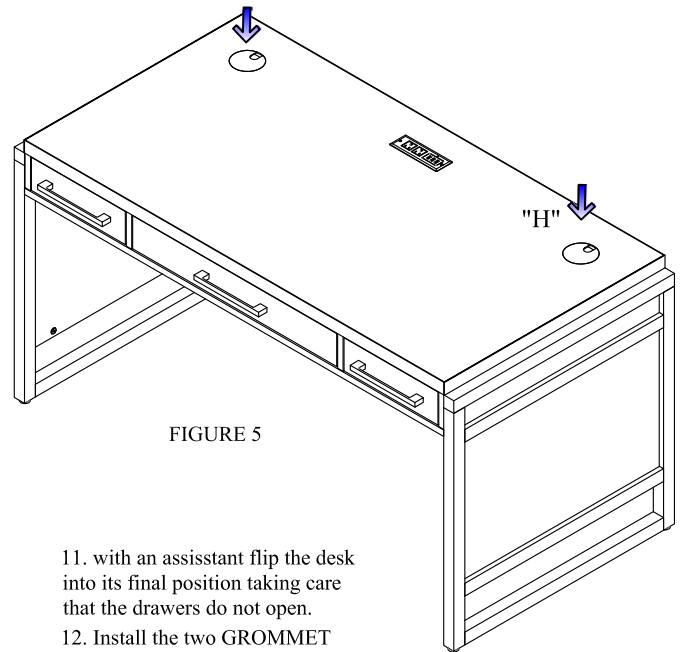

11. with an assistant flip the desk into its final position taking care that the drawers do not open.

12. Install the two GROMMET ("H") into the top Fig.5.
