

WARRANTY INFORMATION

1 YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

Sunbeam Products, Inc. doing business as Jarden Consumer Solutions or if in Canada, Sunbeam Corporation (Canada) Limited doing business as Jarden Consumer Solutions (collectively “JCS”) warrants that for a period of one year from the date of purchase, this product will be free from defects in material and workmanship. JCS, at its option, will repair or replace this product or any component of the product found to be defective during the warranty period. Replacement will be made with a new or remanufactured product or component. If the product is no longer available, replacement may be made with a similar product of equal or greater value. This is your exclusive warranty. Do NOT attempt to repair or adjust any electrical or mechanical functions on this product. Doing so will void this warranty. This warranty is valid for the original retail purchaser from the date of initial retail purchase and is not transferable. Keep the original sales receipt. Proof of purchase is required to obtain warranty performance. JCS dealers, service centers, or retail stores selling JCS products do not have the right to alter, modify or any way change the terms and conditions of this warranty. This warranty does not cover normal wear of parts or damage resulting from any of the following: negligent use or misuse of the product, use on improper voltage or current, use contrary to the operating instructions, disassembly, repair or alteration by anyone other than JCS or an authorized JCS service center. Further, the warranty does not cover: Acts of God, such as fire, flood, hurricanes and tornadoes.

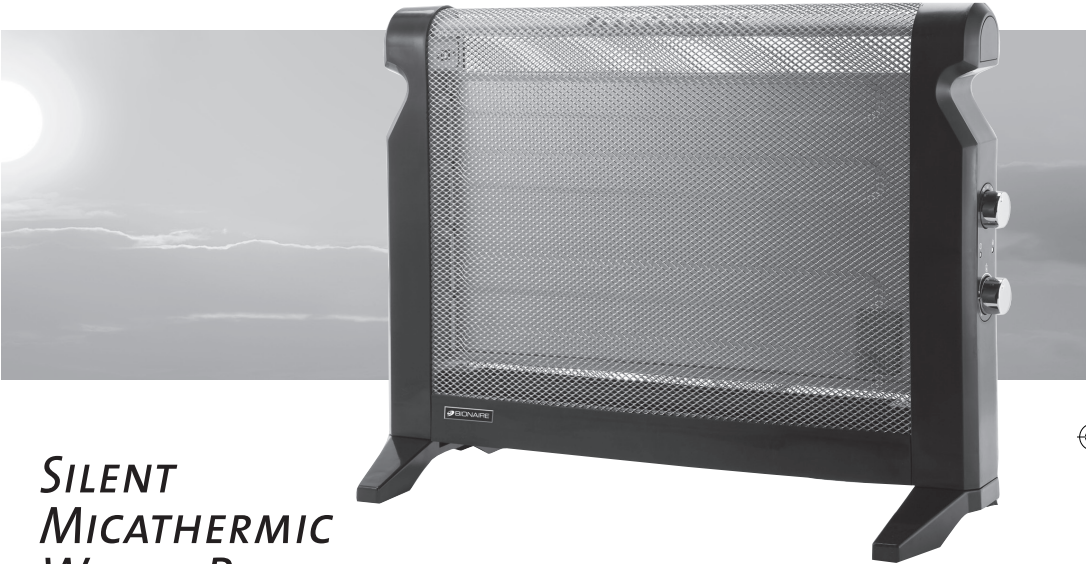

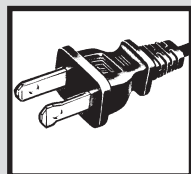

PLEASE READ AND SAVE THESE IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons, including the following:

1. Read all instructions before using this heater.
2. This heater is hot when in use. To avoid burns, do not let bare skin touch hot surfaces. If provided, use handles when moving this heater. Keep combustible materials, such as furniture, pillows, bedding, papers, clothes, and curtains at least 3 feet (0.9 m) from the front of the heater and keep them away from the sides and rear.
3. Extreme caution is necessary when any heater is used by or near children or invalids and whenever the heater is left operating and unattended.
4. Always unplug heater when not in use.
5. Do not operate any heater with a damaged cord or plug or after the heater malfunctions, has been dropped or damaged in any manner. Discard heater, or return to authorized service facility for examination and/or repair.
6. Do not use outdoors.
7. This heater is not intended for use in bathrooms, laundry areas and similar indoor locations. Never locate heater where it may fall into a bathtub or other water container.
8. Do not run cord under carpeting. Do not cover cord with throw rugs, runners, or similar coverings. Do not route cord under furniture or appliances. Arrange cord away from traffic area and where it will not be tripped over.
9. To disconnect heater, turn controls to off, then remove plug from outlet.
10. Do not insert or allow foreign objects to enter any ventilation or exhaust opening as this may cause an electric shock or fire, or damage the heater.



THIS APPLIANCE HAS A POLARIZED PLUG (one blade is wider than the other). To reduce the risk of electric shock, this plug is intended to fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician to install the proper outlet.

DO NOT ATTEMPT TO MODIFY THIS PLUG OR DEFEAT THIS SAFETY FEATURE IN ANY WAY.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

11. To prevent a possible fire, do not block air intakes or exhaust in any manner. Do not use on soft surfaces, like a bed, where openings may become blocked.
12. A heater has hot and arcing or sparking parts inside. Do not use it in areas where gasoline, paint, or flammable liquids are used or stored.
13. Use this heater only as described in this manual. Any other use not recommended by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
14. Always plug heaters directly into a wall outlet/receptacle. Never use with an extension cord or relocatable power tap (outlet/power strip).
15. When unplugging, be sure to pull by the plug and not the cord.
16. If the heater will not operate, see specific instructions on Auto Safety Shut-off.
17. DO NOT attempt to repair or adjust any electrical or mechanical functions on this unit. Doing so will void your warranty. The inside of the unit contains no user serviceable parts. All servicing should be performed by qualified personnel only.
18. Discontinue use if plug or outlet is hot. It is recommended that the outlet be replaced if plug or outlet is hot to touch.
19. The heater must not be located immediately below a socket-outlet. Do not use this heater in the immediate surroundings of a bath, a shower or a swimming pool.

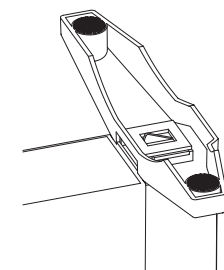
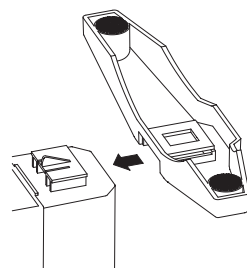
Feet Assembly

There are two feet packed within the box that you will need to attach to the heater (Please refer to Fig. 1).

1. Using force, attach one of the feet to the bottom housing of the heater (as shown in Fig. 1). The foot will snap into place and is not meant to be taken apart after attached to the heater.
2. Using the second foot provided, repeat instructions in step 1.

NOTE: This unit cannot operate without the feet properly secured on the bottom of the heater.

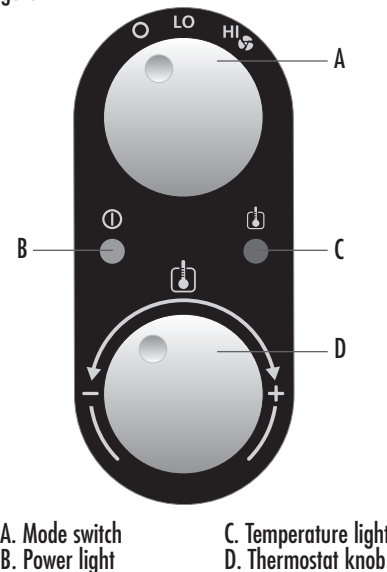
PRE-OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Carefully remove your heater from the box.
2. Make sure the unit is in the OFF position before plugging the heater into the outlet.
3. Place the heater on a firm, level surface.
4. Avoid overloading your circuit by not using other high wattage appliances in the same outlet. At 1500 Watts, this unit draws 12.5 Amps.

NOTE: This unit is for FLOOR USE ONLY.

- There may be an odor coming from the heater the first time you use it. This is normal during the break-in period. Make sure the heater is in a well ventilated area and continue running it until the smell goes away.
- You may hear a popping or crackling sound as the heater heats up. This is normal and safe operation. Once the heater heats up, the crackling sound will go away.

SETTING THE THERMOSTAT

1. Turn the Mode Knob to LO or HI and the Thermostat to the highest setting; allow the heater to warm up the room.
2. When the desired comfort level is reached, slowly lower the Thermostat just enough to stop the heater.
3. The heater automatically turns ON and OFF to maintain the selected comfort level.
4. The Temperature light turns on and off as the heater cycles to indicate that the heater is maintaining the selected comfort level.
5. The Power light illuminates when the heater is plugged into the outlet.

NOTE:

- It is normal for the heater to cycle ON and OFF as it maintains the selected comfort level. To prevent the unit from cycling, you need to raise the thermostat setting.
- On high setting the fan will operate, on low setting the fan will not operate.

AUTO SAFETY SHUT-OFF

This heater is equipped with a patented, technologically-advanced safety system that automatically shuts off the current to the heater when a potential overheat temperature is reached. The heater can only resume operation when you reset it.

To Reset the Heater:

1. Turn the Heat Control to the OFF (O) position.
2. Unplug the unit and wait 30 minutes.
3. Plug in and turn ON the heater.

Tip-Over Shut Off:

If the heater is knocked over, it will instantly shut off. To reset, simply place the heater in an upright position and turn ON the heater.

CLEANING / MAINTENANCE

During Season Care:

Always unplug the heater, and let it cool, before moving or cleaning.

1. Carefully wipe the unit with a soft, damp cloth. Please be very cautious near the motor and heating elements.
2. NEVER use abrasive or flammable solvents to clean the unit.
3. After cleaning, be sure to completely dry the unit with a cloth or towel.

After Season Care:

Store heater in a cool, dry location in the box it came in.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If your heater fails to operate:

- The temperature may be set too low. Turn the thermostat knob clockwise until the heater restarts.
- Make sure selector is in LO or HI setting.
- UNPLUG THE UNIT and make sure the heater is placed in an upright position.
- Make sure the electrical outlet or circuit breaker is working.
- Check for obstructions. If you find an obstruction turn the heater OFF, and unplug the unit. Carefully remove the obstruction and follow the reset instructions.
