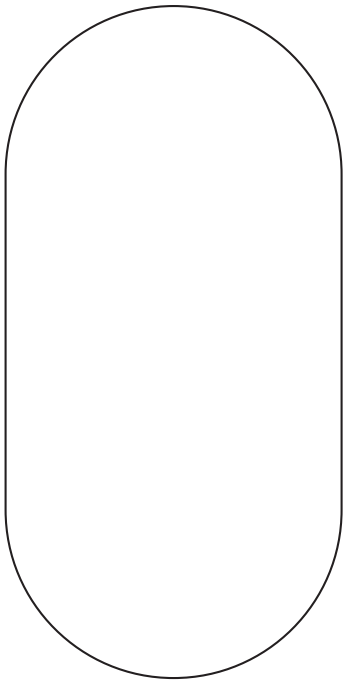

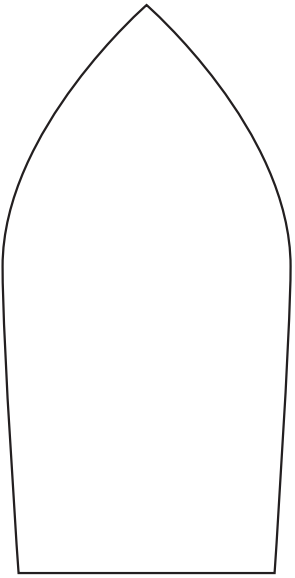
- Penguin wing template
- Penguin belly template

How to Make It

- 1 Using the templates, help crafters trace the penguin belly onto white construction paper and two penguin wings onto black construction paper and cut all three pieces out.
- 2 Assist crafters in cutting two strips—one two inches wide and the other three inches wide—from the leftover black construction paper.
- 3 Have crafters roll each strip into a cylinder shape and secure both closed with craft tape.
- 4 Invite crafters to glue the belly onto the larger cylinder to create the penguin's body. Then they should glue the smaller cylinder on top of the larger one.
- 5 Prompt crafters to glue on the two wings and then bring their penguins to life by adding fun details using wiggly eyes, foam shapes and glitter designers.
- 6 Once the materials dry, this adorable penguin is ready to chill out!
