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Assembly Instructions For Symphony Connecting Tables

Tools required: Phillips screwdriver and Allen wrench. (Included in hardware pack)

Note: These instructions are intended for various models and configurations. Your products may not look exactly as those shown in the diagrams.

Important: The assembly process requires that some hardware be kept loose until later in the sequence. Follow these instructions closely to ensure correct assembly.

Recommendation: Retighten all bolts on a seasonal basis to ensure your product remains strong and stable for many years of use.


Parts List

Tabletop Support Tubes, 2 pcs.

Hardware Pack

1 1/2" Allen Bolts, 4 pcs. 1/2" Phillips Screws, 4 pcs. Allen Wrench

- 1. Unpack and identify all parts.
- 2. Assemble chair frames individually according to chair instructions. Do not attach seat and back cushions yet.
- 3. Place glass tabletop with the silver disks facing up on a clean, carpeted or otherwise protected surface to avoid scratching.
- Attach support tubes to tabletop using 1 1/2" Allen bolts as shown in figure 1. Be sure slots at ends of support tubes are facing up. Tighten bolts securely.
- 5. Position chairs about 10" apart and place connecting table between them, as shown in figure 2.
- 6. Slotted brackets should fit over chair frame tubes, as shown in figure 3.
- Align slotted brackets with holes in chair frame tubes and attach using 1/2" Phillips screws. Tighten securely.
- Your table is now connected. Finish chair assembly by attaching seat and back cushions according to the chair assembly instructions.
