

CARE AND MAINTENANCE GUIDE

PORCELAIN TABLE TOP SURFACES

Tables By Design™ brings together refined materials and purposeful design for everyday living. Porcelain surfaces are selected for their durability, low maintenance, and resistance to heat, stains, moisture, and daily wear - helping your surface maintain its appearance over time.

Due to its extremely low porosity, porcelain is highly resistant to stains and chemicals in everyday use, making it ideal for table surfaces in **both indoor and outdoor applications**.

EVERYDAY CARE & CLEANING

- Porcelain surfaces are fairly easy to clean. Use a microfiber cloth to remove dust from the surface. Clean daily if necessary.
- Porcelain surfaces can be washed with warm water and a mild detergent or a pH-neutral cleaner suitable for hard surface use. Rinse with warm water and dry with a cloth or similar.
- If liquids are spilled, they must be dried immediately, the faster you clean the spill, the easier it is to remove any potential stain.
- Do not use products containing hydrofluoric acid and its derivatives.
- It is not advisable to use waxes, oils, soaps, or any impregnating agents. Some detergents may contain waxes or polishing additives that can leave an oily film on the surface.
- Ceramic knives may scratch porcelain surfaces in any finish.
- Matte porcelain surfaces should be cleaned routinely with a pH-neutral cleaner.

RECOMMENDED CLEANING GUIDANCE & MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE:

- For daily cleaning, use warm water and a soft cloth or microfiber towel.
- For routine maintenance, use a pH-neutral cleaner suitable for hard surfaces.
- For more difficult soils or periodic deep cleaning, a diluted alkaline cleaner may be used following the cleaner manufacturer's instructions regarding proper usage, dilution, and contact time.
- Improper use of cleaning agents may damage the surface.

SURFACE CARE NOTES

Porcelain is designed for durability, but proper care will help preserve the original appearance. Avoid dropping heavy objects, especially on edges and corners, as this may cause damage.

TABLE BASE CARE & CLEANING

- Clean with mild, pH-neutral household cleaners suitable for finished surfaces.
- Avoid harsh or incompatible chemicals, solvents, or cleaning agents not intended for finished surfaces.

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QUARTZ TABLE TOP SURFACES

Due to its non-porous engineered composition, quartz is highly resistant to everyday staining and ideal for table surfaces used in **indoor dining and living spaces**.

Not intended for outdoor usage.

EVERYDAY CARE & CLEANING:

- For daily cleaning, use warm water and a soft cloth or paper towel.
- For routine maintenance, use a pH-neutral cleaner suitable for hard surfaces.
- For more difficult soils or stubborn residue, a diluted alkaline cleaner may be used following the cleaner manufacturer's instructions regarding proper usage, dilution, and contact time.
- Improper use of cleaning agents may damage the surface.

FOR COMMON HOUSEHOLD SPILLS:

Common household spills - such as coffee, tea, juices, and oils - should be cleaned promptly using warm water and a pH-neutral cleaner.

FOR STUBBORN SPILLS & MARKINGS:

For stubborn or dried spills, use a non-abrasive cleaning pad with a pH-neutral cleaner or a diluted alkaline cleaner.

To remove adhered dried material, carefully loosen and remove excess material using a non-abrasive scraping tool suitable for the surface.

Warning: Always follow the cleaning product manufacturer's instructions, including proper usage, dilution, and contact time. Improper use of cleaning agents may damage the surface.

SCRATCHES:

Quartz surfaces are highly durable but not scratch-proof. Avoid cutting directly on the surface or contact with sharp objects, as this may cause scratching.

AVOID:

Avoid exposure to harsh or incompatible chemicals, solvents, or cleaning agents not intended for use on engineered stone surfaces. If contact occurs, rinse promptly and thoroughly with clean water.

Always follow cleaning product instructions and ensure suitability for the surface prior to use.

INTENSE HEAT:

Quartz surfaces tolerate brief exposure to moderately hot temperatures. Use trivets or hot pads to protect the table surface against direct heat from hot cookware or appliances. Do not place hot items directly on the surface.

TABLE BASE CARE & CLEANING

- Clean with mild, pH-neutral household cleaners suitable for finished surfaces.
- Avoid harsh or incompatible chemicals, solvents, or cleaning agents not intended for finished surfaces.
