Treatment Questions

1 What advantages does Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment offer over other fluoride treatments?

Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment contains 9,500 ppm fluoride and stabilised calcium phosphate technology in a water-based coating. Utilising a water-based coating allows the fluoride, calcium, and phosphate in the solution to be available as soon as it is applied to tooth surfaces.

The product creates a clear, slick, smooth coating on the teeth which aids in patient comfort and treatment compliance.

Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment's formula is ideal for all patients, especially those who may require a shorter treatment time, are allergic to colophony, dislike the mouthfeel of traditional fluoride varnish treatments, or cannot tolerate a tray-based fluoride gel application.

2 How long should my patients leave Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment on their teeth?

The required treatment period for Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment is 15 minutes. In laboratory studies, Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment has high fluoride uptake in the first 15 minutes after application. Patients should refrain from eating, drinking, or rinsing for a required time of 15 minutes after application to achieve the maximum benefit.

3 How does Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment achieve effective fluoride uptake in just 15 minutes of required contact time?

In rosin-based and shellac-based coatings, the patient's saliva must dissolve the sticky coating to release the beneficial minerals, requiring longer treatment time.

Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment is already in solution, so fluoride, calcium, and phosphate are ready to release upon contact with tooth surfaces. This allows for greater and more complete ion release with a required contact time of just 15 minutes.

4 Are there any contraindications to the use of 3M™ Clinpro™ Clear Fluoride Treatment?

There are no known contraindications to using Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment. Formula is free of rosin and common allergens.

5 Can patients undergoing orthodontic treatment use Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment?

Patients undergoing orthodontic treatment with traditional brackets or clear tray aligners may use Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment. Laboratory testing demonstrates that Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment is safe and compatible to use throughout all types of orthodontic treatment.

6 Should patients stop using fluoride rinses or supplements after application of Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment?

Patients should not use prescriptive fluoride preparations such as gels or rinses for 24 hours after application of Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment.

7 How much Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment should I use and how often can it be applied?

Many dental professionals apply Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment twice per year, but the product can be applied more frequently if needed. A thin coating of the product is all that is needed on patient's teeth, but it is safe to use the entire unit dose based on your patient's treatment needs.

Formula Questions

1 What's the difference between a water-based and a traditional rosin-based or shellac-based fluoride treatment?

Traditional rosin-based and shellac-based fluoride varnishes are sticky coatings with suspended sodium fluoride particles. With a water-based fluoride treatment, dissolved fluoride ions are readily available immediately upon application to the teeth.

Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment's water-based formula with 2.1% sodium fluoride allows for equivalent or better fluoride uptake than traditional 5% varnish treatments, even at a lower dosage of fluoride.

2 What are the benefits of added calcium and phosphate?

Calcium and phosphate are the building blocks of tooth enamel. 3M™ Clinpro™ Clear Fluoride Treatment contains calcium and phosphate minerals in the form of stabilised calcium phosphate technology. This technology is created by embedding calcium into a cross-linking polymer lattice. The polymer lattice separates the calcium from the fluoride in the composition until the product is spread onto teeth during application. When fluoride, calcium, and phosphate are released together, they have a better chance of combining to form strong tooth mineral.

3 Will Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment damage surfaces or clog suction lines?

Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment has a water-based formulation and is easy to clean from unwanted surfaces. The water-based formulation will not clog suction lines. Clinpro Clear Fluoride Treatment can be easily wiped from unwanted surfaces with a damp cloth and washes completely from scrubs and other fabrics.

L-Pop Unit Dose Questions

1 How does the unique L-Pop unit dose make application fast and easy?

The L-Pop eliminates the need to peel or tear open packaging and is simply activated by pressing the package and delivering the product into the attached dispensing well. The L-Pop includes a single-use applicator brush that allows the product to be applied quickly and easily to any tooth surfaces. The water-based formula can be applied directly from the L-Pop well or be dispensed onto the back of a gloved hand.

2 What is the optimal way to dispense the product?

Dental professionals should press the L-Pop slowly, and may find it helpful to press lower on the L-Pop, near the press symbol, rather than pressing near the dispensing well.
