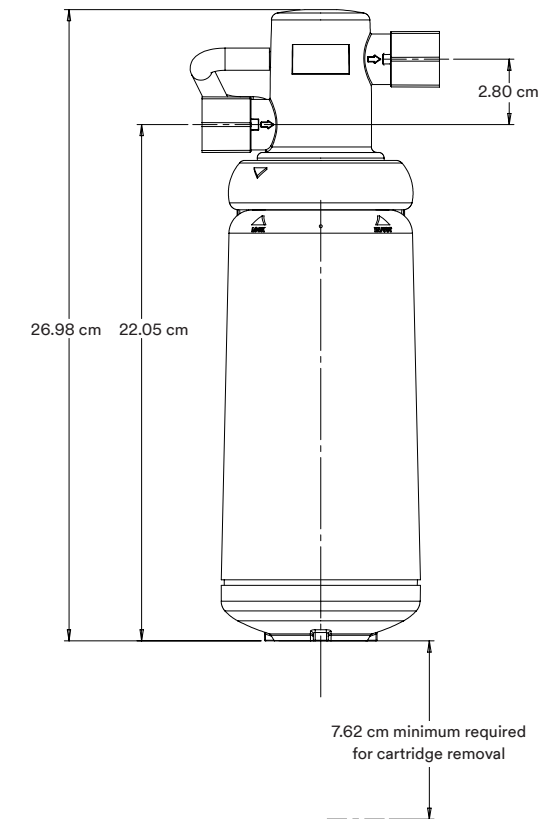

- Head assembly are available with integral mounting bracket, and Inlet and outlet plumbing connections 3/8" BSPT or JG.

- System maximum operating pressure of 862 kPa (125 psi) and operating temperature of 37.8 °C (100 °F).
- Recommended service flow rate is up to 3.8 lpm (1.0 gpm).
- Filter cartridges incorporate a carbon block filtration medium that contains an antimicrobial agent, silver, to protect the filter's performance.

- Cartridges are sanitary in design, requiring no contact with the filter media during cartridge change-out.

- **DO NOT install** where water hammer conditions may occur. If water hammer conditions exist you must install a water hammer arrester. Contact a plumbing professional if you are uncertain how to check for this condition.
- The disposable filter cartridge **MUST** be replaced every twelve (12) months, at the rated capacity or sooner if a noticeable reduction in flow rate occurs.
