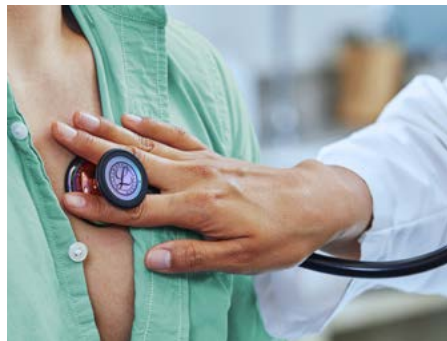

Lightweight design

Littmann stethoscopes are lighter than other stethoscopes** and designed to feel comfortable when draped around your neck or carried in a pocket, giving you an extra step in your day.

Tunable diaphragm technology

Hear different frequency sounds without turning over and repositioning the chestpiece. Just hold the chestpiece with light pressure to hear low frequency sounds, or press a little more to hear higher frequency sounds.

Precision chestpiece

Double-sided chestpieces have precision stems that rotate smoothly and click into position.
