Application and Removal Guide

3M™ Tube Securement Device Application



Initiate application


- · Open package.
- Completely remove the device from the liner.



Apply first wing

• While minimizing tube manipulation, apply one wing (half) of the device onto the patient's skin.

Note: Do not stretch device during application as tension may result in skin trauma.



- Align the tube along the center "body" of the device.
- Fully wrap the device around the tube.




- Apply the other wing (half) of the device onto the patient's skin.
- Apply firm pressure on the device, including the edges, to enhance the adhesion to the skin and to the tubing.




Check final positioning

• Ensure the tube is lifted slightly from the skin to reduce the risk of pressure injury.



3M™ Tube Securement Device Replacement or Removal



Initiate removal

- Minimize tube manipulation during removal.
- Peel back one corner of the device.



Remove first wing

- Stabilize the tube to the patient.
- Keep device parallel to skin.
- Completely remove one wing.

Note: Peel low and slow.



- Carefully peel the device off the tube.
 Remove the remaining wing of the device from the skin.

Note: Peel low and slow.
