

## Frequently Asked Questions

- 1 What does the procedure require?**

Treatment typically includes two appointments. At your first appointment the dentist will take photos and a digital or physical impression of your teeth. At the next appointment, your doctor will perform the composite restoration and you will walk out with your new smile.
- 2 How long will the results last?**

Composites are a durable and clinically proven restorative material. Your dentist can advise you on how to maximize the longevity—including proper hygiene habits.
- 3 How do I care for the restoration?**

Your beautiful smile may be new, but the way you care for it is the same regular brushing and flossing. The great thing about composite restorations is they can be repaired quickly and easily if damaged.
